1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL: Mayor Pat Mikesh called the City Canvass Board Meeting for November 13th, 2018, to order at 5:45 p.m. Present: Mayor Pat Mikesh, Councilmembers Tom Conway, Ryan Leckner, Erika Randall, and Liz Stone. Absent: None. Staff Present: Administrator John McKinney, Treasurer Angela Brumbaugh, Public Facilities Superintendent Chris Fieldsend, Public Works Superintendent Scott Burlingame, and Clerk Margie Vik. Others Present: Chuck Schmitz, Tom and Gail Petschl, and Robin Fish from the Enterprise.

The City Council recited the Oath of Office for the Park Rapids City Canvass Board.

2. CANVASS BOARD:

2.1. Resolution Approving the Election Results for the November 6, 2018, Municipal Election by the Canvass Board for the City of Park Rapids: Vik stated you have before you the election results. The total write-in votes for Ryan Leckner were 690. The abstract shows the write-in votes at 650. That is the total of the tapes from the polling place and from the absentee ballots. The election judges have to go through every ballot by hand and look to see the how and for who the actual votes were cast. That total is 690. That is the result of the write-in ballots cast for Ryan Leckner.

After reviewing and discussing the election vote totals, which included the absentee ballot counts, the Canvass Board declared Ryan Leckner elected to the Office of Mayor, Tom Conway and Erika Randall elected to the Office of Councilmember, then the following motion was made: **A motion was made by Conway, seconded by Randall, and unanimously carried to approve Resolution #2018-163 Approving the Election Results for the November 6, 2018, Municipal Election by the Canvass Board for the City of Park Rapids.**
